

COLLEGE DAY FORM

Seniors may have two school days and second semester Juniors have one school day to visit colleges, trade schools, technical schools, and appointments with military recruiters that they are seriously considering attending. These visits must be prearranged according to these guidelines:

1. Each visit must be arranged with all of your teachers, the counselor, and the principal.
2. Seniors must pick up a College Day Form either in the office or from the counselor. They must fill it out, have it signed by teachers, counselor, and parents, and indicate on the form who they are scheduled to meet with and at what time. The form must be turned in to the office or to the counselor **5 days** before the day of the visit.
3. Failure to follow this procedure will result in an **unexcused** absence.
4. Exceptions to this policy may be made at the discretion of the principal.
5. College Days will be allowed through April 30th only.
6. Military physical exams are considered to be college days.
7. Principal's signature will indicate final permission.
