Rock – a naturally formed solid made of one or more minerals

Sedimentary rock – rock formed from material that has settled into layers

Igneous rock – rock that was once melted and then cooled and hardened

Metamorphic rock – rock that has been changed by heat and pressure

Fossil – the remains of a living thing that died long ago

Mineral – an object that is solid, formed in nature, and has never been alive

The color of the powder left behind by a mineral when it's rubbed against a rough white tile is a streak.

Minerals are identified by 3 properties: hardness, streak, and color.
